






World population statistics Web of Science™ 1998 - 2016 2016


Austria seems not to lag behind

Applied biochar research in Austrian fields:



Deep positioning (20 cm) of a biochar-slurry mixture

 $30 \text{ m}^3 \text{ slurry} + 1 - 2 \text{ t biochar per ha}$

16 field experiments, mainly corn and pumpkin

- Recommended application:
 - 1 % of total feed






 Special report of the Austrian Advisory Council for Soil Fertility is being prepared about agricultural applications of biochar

Outlook: future biochar research directions

- Nutrient recycling: Biochar from additional waste materials as secondary resource for N, P, micronutrients
- Application techniques for biochar
- Biochar as growth substrate / as interface of C- and N-cycle
- Biochar for water filtering / wastewater purification
- Biochar as pollutant sorbent: bespoke, surface-modified biochars for specific pollutant combinations; biochar composites
